Position Summary

The Ambulex Emergency Medical Technician Volunteer will be the first responder to emergency calls from the communities that they are based in, and will assess the patient and provide information to the response team that will inform ambulatory vehicle response decisions.

What you will do

1. Provide first response services to calls made from communities to ASL
2. Communicate patient status and provide information needed to make a decision on the dispatch of an ambulatory vehicle
3. Ensure that the trauma kit entrusted in your care is clean and fully equipped at all times.
4. Take monthly stock of medical supplies and tools in the trauma kit entrusted in your care, and share the information with your supervisor
5. Compile and share with your supervisor monthly reports on the emergency response activities within your area.
6. Reconcile monthly response expenditure and provide report your supervisor

What you will be

1. You respect and uphold human life and value human dignity. Respect for human rights is an essential virtue in providing emergency health services and will be a non-negotiable attribute.
2. You are energetic and full of passion for saving lives.

3. You are an excellent communicator, with the ability to speak compassionately and persuasively to patients/customers
4. You have the ability to build positive and productive relationships with a wide range of people and stakeholders in communities.
5. You are flexible and a good team player.
6. Self-driven and passionate about giving back to your community.

You will offer:

2. A Certificate/ Diploma in Emergency Medical Training from a recognized institution
3. Minimum 2 years of relevant experience providing EMR services in Kenya
